The Lillooet Naturalist Society would like to register our concerns and objection to the application for heli-skiing, heli-hiking and heli-fishing by Coast Range Heliskiing Ltd.

We do not object to skiing, hiking or fishing in the area but we do object to helicopters. The intensity and frequency of the helicopters in this application would be disruptive to wildlife and detract from the beauty and serenity of the area.

Grizzly bear and other species at risk in our area need a sanctuary and the Duffey Lake area and Cayoose Creek corridor provide an area for wildlife and also for the enjoyment of non-motorized recreation. We would like to advocate for the existing values for wildlife and quiet recreational activities.

We do not support the application for helicopter recreational activities.
