Fish, Wildlife & Habitat Coalition



The Fish, Wildlife & Habitat Coalition hosted two events for Members of the Legislative Assembly in Victoria October 18, 2023, asking both government and opposition members to support a strong Biodiversity and Ecosystem Health Framework, to protect intact threatened and important places and to budget \$200m for fish & wildlife conservation. The Coalition includes 27 organizations (including BC Nature) with diverse interests from environmental non-government organizations, hunting and angling guides, conservation organizations, wildlife viewing, ecotourism, naturalists, hunters, anglers and trappers with over 273,000 members and more than 900 businesses across BC.
