Learn about a fascinating and unique fish in Seton and Anderson Lakes. Liam Ragan, Key Biodiversity program manager with BC Nature, will talk about BC Nature and Tsal'alh's partnership to monitor and protect their endemic Gwenis.

Gwenis are a jet black, winter spawning kokanee confined to Anderson and Seton lakes with huge cultural and ecological significance to the area. Thanks to funding from the BC Watershed Security Fund we're working to understand declines in this unique population and ensure their continued survival.
